### **BRIEF BACKGROUND**

CARE International has been working in Uganda for more than 50 years, both supporting development process and humanitarian responses with strong program and program support capacity and through partnerships on the ground. CARE has started the response to the DRC influx in February 2018 with focus on GBV prevention and response and Sexual, Reproductive Health (SRH). CARE in Uganda through Care Denmark has secured funding from DERF to implement a project “Humanitarian GBV and Protection Intervention for Congolese Refugees in Kyangwali Settlement” that will be jointly implemented with Kabarole Research and Resource Centre (KRC).
